REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 23, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. The Second Schedule of the principal regulations, as substituted by regulation 2 of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 17, is hereby amended by inserting therein in its appropriate alphabetical order the following item:
