**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 25th day of September 1957

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Rabbits Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

**REGULATIONS**

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 25, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations, as substituted by regulation 2 of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 17, is hereby amended by inserting therein in its appropriate alphabetical order the following item:
