HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Rabbit Nuisance Act 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 9, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1949* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

2. The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule, and substituting the Second Schedule set out in the First Schedule to these regulations.

3. The regulations specified in the Second Schedule hereto are hereby consequentially revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*]

These regulations add the Edendale, Glencoe, New River Hundred, and Woodlands Rabbit Boards to the list of Boards which have power to control the trapping, shooting, hunting, &c., of rabbits in their districts. The regulations consolidate the list of the Boards which have these powers.
