PURSUANT to the Rabbits Act 1955, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 2, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1962* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting from subclause (1) the words "referred to in the First Schedule hereto".
- 3. Regulation 3 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "referred to in the First Schedule hereto".
- 4. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the words "referred to in the First Schedule hereto".
- 5. (1) The principal regulations are hereby further amended by revoking the First Schedule.
- (2) The Rabbit Destruction Regulations 1962, Amendment No. 1, are hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations confer on all Rabbit Boards the power to control the trapping, shooting, hunting, etc., of rabbits in their districts. Previously this power was conferred on specified Boards only.
