PURSUANT to the Restricted Drugs Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Restricted Drugs Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 20, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Restricted Drugs Regulations 1964*.

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
