THE RIGHT HON. SIR ROBERT MULDOON PRESIDING IN COUNCIL PURSUANT to the Restricted Drugs Act 1960, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Restricted Drugs Regulations 1964, Amendment No. 21, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Restricted Drugs Regulations 1964* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the Gazette.
