ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 14th day of September 1992

Present:

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 3A of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934 (as inserted by section 4 of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Amendment Act 1992), Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and being satisfied that substantial reciprocity of treatment will be assured as respects the enforcement in Australia of money judgments given in District Courts in New Zealand, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments (Australian Inferior Courts) Order 1992.
- (2) This order shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Specified inferior Courts—It is hereby directed that the Courts specified in the Schedule to this order (being Courts of Australian States or Australian Territories) are specified inferior Courts for the purposes of Part I of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order directs that certain "inferior" Courts of States and Territories of Australia are to be "specified inferior Courts" for the purposes of Part I of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934.

Money judgments of such Courts are, in the circumstances set out in that Part of that Act, judgments to which that Part of that Act applies.
