Pursuant to the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act, 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, being satisfied in respect of the matters referred to in section 3 of that Act, and acting by and with the advice of the Executive Council, doth hereby order as follows:—

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Order 1951.
- 2. Part I of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act, 1934, shall extend to those parts of His Majesty's dominions (including territories under His Majesty's protection) named in the first column of the Schedule hereto.
- 3. The respective Courts specified in the second column of the Schedule hereto shall, for the purposes of Part I of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act, 1934, be deemed to be superior Courts of the respective parts of His Majesty's dominions named in the first column of the Schedule hereto.
- 4. The Schedule to the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Order 1940* is hereby amended by revoking the heading "Malaya" and all the words following that heading.
