**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 20th day of July 1955

PURSUANT to the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, being satisfied in respect of the matters referred to in section 3 of the said Act, and acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

**ORDER**

1. This order may be cited as the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Order 1955.

2. Part I of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934 shall extend to the Australian Capital Territory.

3. The Supreme Court of the Australian Capital Territory shall be deemed to be the superior Court of the Australian Capital Territory for the purposes of Part I of the Reciprocal Enforcement of Judgments Act 1934.
