THE RATING EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

C. L. N. NEWALL, Governor-General. ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government Buildings at Wellington, this 15th day of July, 1942.

THE RIGHT HON. P. FRASER PRESIDING IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rating Emergency Regulations 1942.

EXTENSION OF TIME FOR RECOVERY OF RATES.

2. While these regulations continue in force section 77 of the Rating Act, 1925,* shall be read and construed as if it had been amended by omitting the words "three years", and substituting the words "five years"; and also by omitting from the proviso the words "four years", and substituting the words "six years".
