HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rehabilitation Emergency Regulations 1943.

2. While these regulations continue in force, section 2 of the Rehabilitation Act, 1941, shall be read and construed as if it had been amended by omitting from subsection (5) the words "if the child's mother is deceased".
