ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Forest and Rural Fires Act 1977, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

**1. Title and commencement**—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Rural Fire Districts Regulations 1980, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rural Fire Districts Regulations 1980\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1987.

**2. Interpretation**—Regulation 2 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting, after the definition of the term “forestry co-operative”, the following definition”

“ ‘Minister’ means the Minister of Forestry”.

**3. Application**—Regulation 3 (a) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the word “Forests”, and substituting the word “Conservation”.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

These regulations amend the Rural Fire Districts Regulations 1980 to take into account the abolition of the New Zealand Forest Service and the establishment of the Ministry of Forestry and the Department of Conservation.
