

THE REGISTRATION FOR EMPLOYMENT ORDER NO. 7

PURSUANT to Regulation 9c of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940,* the Minister of Industrial Man-power doth hereby order and direct as follows :---

1. This Order may be cited as the Registration for Employment Order No. 7.

2. Subject to the exemptions hereinafter specified, every male person who at the date of this Order—

- (a) Is not a British subject either by birth or by naturalization; and
- (b) Is resident in New Zealand within the meaning of Regulation 5 of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940; and
- (c) Has attained the age of eighteen years but has not attained the age of forty-six years,-

shall within seven days after the date of this Order register for employment by completing a form provided for the purpose and delivering it to a District Man-power Officer either personally or by registered post.

3. Subject to the exemptions hereinafter specified, every male person who at any time after the date of this Order becomes resident in New Zealand and at that time is not a British subject either by birth or by naturalization and has attained the age of eighteen years but has not attained the age of forty-six years shall within seven days thereafter register for employment in the manner prescribed in clause 2 hereof.

4. Subject to the exemptions hereinafter specified, every male person who at any time after the date of this Order attains the age of eighteen years and at that time is not a British subject either by birth or by naturalization and is resident in New Zealand shall within seven days thereafter register for employment in the manner prescribed in clause 2 hereof.

5. Every person who for the time being belongs to any one or more of the classes specified in the Schedule hereto shall be exempt from compliance with clause 2 or clause 3 or clause 4 of this Order.

6. If at any time after the date of this Order any person ceases to be exempted under the last preceding clause from compliance with clause 2 or clause 3 or clause 4 of this Order he shall within seven days thereafter register for employment in the manner prescribed in clause 2 hereof.

SCHEDULE.

EXEMPTIONS.

PERSONS registered or deemed to be registered for the purposes of Regulation 9c of the National Service Emergency Regulations 1940.

Persons rendering continuous service as members of any of His Majesty's naval, military, or air forces.

Persons employed as civilians by the Royal New Zealand Navy, the Army Department, or the Royal New Zealand Air Force.

Persons serving in merchant ships.

Persons who are outside New Zealand.

Persons in receipt of invalids' benefits under the Social Security Act, 1938.

Persons in receipt of war pensions for disablement, assessed at not less than 75 per cent., which has arisen from service in any of His Majesty's naval, military, or air forces.

Inmates of any hospital or of the New Zealand Institute for the Blind.

Persons in respect of whom reception-orders are in force under the Mental Defectives Act, 1911 (whether or not they are detained in institutions under that Act), or who are detained as voluntary boarders under that Act. Persons undergoing sentences of imprisonment or detained in Borstal institutions.
