### ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Economic Stabilisation Act 1948, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

---

### REGULATIONS

**1. Title**—These regulations may be cited as the Rent Freeze Regulations 1983, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rent Freeze Regulations 1983\* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

**2. Commencement and expiry**—(1) These regulations shall come into force on the day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

(2) These regulations shall continue in force until the close of the 31st day of March 1984, and shall then expire.

**3. Rent freeze extended for 1 month**—(1) Regulation 2 (2) of the principal regulations is hereby amended by omitting the expression “29th day of February”, and substituting the expression “31st day of March”.

(2) The principal regulations are hereby amended by omitting from regulations 4 (1), 4 (2), 5 (1), 5 (2), 6 (1), 6 (2), and 9 (2) (c) the expression “29th day of February” wherever it occurs, and substituting in each case the expression “31st day of March”.
