### Regulations

- 1 Title**  
 These regulations are the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2006.

## 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

## 3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Regulations 2003.

## 4 Regulation 10 amended

(1) Regulation 10(2) is amended by adding the following paragraph:

“(i) Transpower New Zealand, if the application or review may affect the national grid.”

(2) Regulation 10 is amended by adding the following subclause:

“(4) For the purposes of subclause (2)(i), **national grid** has the same meaning as in section 2 of the Electricity Act 1992.”

### Explanatory note

*This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.*

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Regulations 2003.

Regulation 10 is amended by—

- inserting new *subclause (2)(i)* to provide that a consent authority must serve a notice required under regulation 10(1) on Transpower New Zealand if certain applications or reviews may affect the national grid:
