# Regulations

#### 1 Title

These regulations are the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Amendment Regulations (No 2) 2006.

#### 2 Commencement

These regulations come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.

## 3 Principal regulations amended

These regulations amend the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Regulations 2003.

### 4 Regulation 10 amended

- (1) Regulation 10(2) is amended by adding the following paragraph:
  - "(i) Transpower New Zealand, if the application or review may affect the national grid."
- (2) Regulation 10 is amended by adding the following subclause:
- "(4) For the purposes of subclause (2)(i), **national grid** has the same meaning as in section 2 of the Electricity Act 1992."

## **Explanatory note**

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*, amend the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Regulations 2003.

Regulation 10 is amended by-

• inserting new *subclause* (2)(i) to provide that a consent authority must serve a notice required under regulation 10(1) on Transpower New Zealand if certain applications or reviews may affect the national grid:
