1 Title

2 Commencement

These regulations come into force on 1 August 2003.

3 Regulation 3 and First Schedule revoked

The principal regulations are amended by revoking regulation 3 and the First Schedule.

Explanatory note

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which amend the Resource Management (Transitional, Fees, Rents, and Royalties) Regulations 1991, come into force on 1 August 2003, the same day as the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Regulations 2003.

The effect of the amendments is to revoke the schedule of fees for various applications. Schedule 2 of the Resource Management (Forms, Fees, and Procedure) Regulations 2003 sets out the application fees that have to date been included as the First Schedule of the principal regulations.
