ORDER IN COUNCIL

HER EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 167 of the Resource Management Act 1991, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and on the recommendation of the Minister for the Environment, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Resource Management (Approval of Dunedin Airport Limited as Requiring Authority) Order 1992.

(2) This order shall come into force on the 7th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Interpretation—In this order, unless the context otherwise requires, “airport” has the meaning given to that term by section 2 of the Airport Authorities Act 1966.

3. General approval—Dunedin Airport Limited is hereby approved as a requiring authority under section 167 of the Resource Management Act 1991 for the operation, maintenance, and expansion of the airport known as Dunedin Airport and for the extension to the south, by approximately 190 metres, of the runway at that airport.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

By this order Dunedin Airport Limited is approved under section 167 of the Resource Management Act 1991 as a requiring authority for the operation, maintenance, and expansion of Dunedin Airport and for the extension to the south, by approximately 190 metres, of the runway at that airport.
