THE RASPBERRY MARKETING REGULATIONS 1950, AMENDMENT NO. 1

Pursuant to the Marketing Act 1936 and the Agriculture (Emergency Powers) Act 1934, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Raspberry Marketing Regulations 1950, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and form part of the Raspberry Marketing Regulations 1950* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 2. Regulation 4 of the principal regulations is hereby amended by revoking subclause (1), and substituting the following subclause:—
- "(1) Every person to be appointed to the Council as a representative of a Constituent Committee shall be nominated each year by the Committee of which he is a member within one month after the date on which the annual election of members of the Committee is held and every person so appointed shall hold office until his successor is appointed under these regulations."

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.]

The purpose of the amendment made by regulation 2 is to provide for the annual appointment of members of the Council nominated by Constituent Committees and for the persons appointed to hold office until the appointment of their successors. The present clause has been found unsatisfactory in cases where an election has to be postponed.
