

THE RESOURCE MANAGEMENT (REVOKED REGULATIONS CONTINUANCE) REGULATIONS 1993

ORDER IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 360 (1) (g) of the Resource Management Act 1991, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Resource Management (Revoked Regulations Continuance) Regulations 1993.
- (2) These regulations shall come into force on the 31st day of December 1993.
- 2. Period during which revoked regulations apply—Notwithstanding the revocation of the regulations specified in the Second Schedule to the Resource Management Amendment Act 1993, those regulations shall continue in force in respect of any proceedings to which section 230 of that Act applies.

3. Expiry—These regulations shall expire with the close of the 30th day of September 1996, and on the 1st day of October 1996 shall be deemed to have been revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

Regulation 2 provides that, although the Resource Management Amendment Act 1993 provided that certain regulations were revoked, for the purposes of proceedings which commenced before the date of commencement of that Act, the regulations shall be deemed to continue in force.

Regulation 3 provides for these regulations to expire on 30 September 1996.
