THE RABBIT NUISANCE ACT MODIFICATION EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1942

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 14th day of October, 1942.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rabbit Nuisance Act Modification Emergency Regulations 1942, and shall come into force on the day following the date of publication in the *Gazette* of a notification of the making thereof.

2. In these regulations the expression "the said Act" means the Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1928.

3. (1) While these regulations continue in force, section 39 of the said Act shall be read as if there were omitted therefrom all words after the words "in each year" (where those words first occur) down to and including the words "in each year" (where those words next occur).

(2) All ratepayers' lists which, having been prepared pursuant to the said section for districts in which rates are levied on the basis of the number of head of stock carried on the land of the several ratepayers, are in force on the date of the coming into force of these regulations, shall continue in force until new lists prepared in accordance with the said section, as modified by these regulations, come into force :

Provided that any such list may from time to time, as circumstances require, be amended in accordance with the provisions of section 45 of the said Act.
