THE REHABILITATION (PSYCHIATRIC NURSES) REGULATIONS 1946

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

Pursuant to section 15 of the Rehabilitation Act, 1941, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Rehabilitation (Phychiatric Nurses) Regulations 1946.
- 2. While these regulations continue in force, section 14 of the Nurses and Midwives Act, 1945, shall be read and construed as if it had been amended by adding to paragraph (c) of subsection (1) thereof the words "or that—
 - "(i) He is a discharged serviceman within the meaning of the Rehabilitation Act, 1941;
 - "(ii) He was engaged in nursing duties in a mental hospital before he commenced to serve as a serviceman; and
 - "(iii) He has, before the last day of December, nineteen hundred and forty-seven, passed the said Senior Examination for Mental Nurses."
