**1. Title**—This order may be cited as the Radio New Zealand Act (No. 2) Commencement Order 1996.

**2. Commencement of Radio New Zealand Act (No. 2) 1995**—The Radio New Zealand Act (No. 2) 1995 shall come into force on the 5th day of July 1996.

## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order brings into force, on 5 July 1996, the Radio New Zealand Act (No. 2) 1995. That Act relates to the State enterprise called The Radio Company Limited, established to hold the commercial operations of Radio New Zealand. The Act removes The Radio Company Limited from the State-Owned Enterprises Act 1986, the Ombudsmen Act 1975, the Official Information Act 1982, and other legislation.
