**THE ROYAL NEW ZEALAND AIR FORCE (VISITING FORCES)
ORDER 1955**

PURSUANT to subsection (5) of section 6 of the Visiting Forces Act 1939, I, Lieutenant-General Sir Charles Willoughby Moke Norrie, the Governor-General of New Zealand, hereby make the following order.

ORDER

1. This order may be cited as the Royal New Zealand Air Force (Visiting Forces) Order 1955.

2. It is hereby declared that the portion of the Royal New Zealand Air Force that is for the time being serving as part of the Far East Air Force, Royal Air Force, is serving together and acting in combination with the portions of the air forces of Her Majesty to which section 6 of the Visiting Forces Act 1939 applies and with which the said portion of the Royal New Zealand Air Force is for the time being serving as part of the said Far East Air Force.

3. It is further hereby declared that the aforesaid portion of the Royal New Zealand Air Force shall be under the command of the air or other officer for the time being Commander-in-Chief Far East Air Force, Royal Air Force, and of any officer of the rank of group captain or above to whom he may delegate his powers of command.
