AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 13th day of December 1976

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 37 of the Racing Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title—This order may be cited as the Racing (Totalisator) Order 1974, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Racing (Totalisator) Order 1974* (hereinafter referred to as the principal order).

2. Number of days on which totalisator may be used—Clause 2 (1) of the principal order is hereby amended by adding the following proviso:

“Provided that the aggregate number of days on which totalisators may be authorised to be used in the racing year ending with the 31st day of July 1977 shall be 162 in respect of trotting clubs.”

3. Revocation of this order—This order shall be deemed to have been revoked on the 1st day of August 1977.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases by 1 the number of days on which totalisators may be used in respect of trotting clubs in the racing year ending 31 July 1977.
