ORDER IN COUNCIL

At Wellington this 28th day of October 1986

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 37 of the Racing Act 1971, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following order.

ORDER

1. Title and commencement—(1) This order may be cited as the Racing (Totalisator) Order 1986.

(2) This order shall come into force on the day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*.

2. Total number of licences which may be granted—The combined total number of totalisator licences and restricted totalisator licences which may be granted shall be—

(a) In the racing year ending with the 31st day of July 1987, 646:

(b) In the racing year ending with the 31st day of July 1988 and in subsequent racing years, 648.

3. Revocation—The Racing (Totalisator) Order 1985* is hereby revoked.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order increases the combined total number of licences which may be granted to racing clubs in any racing year from 646 to 648, an increase of 2. The increase applies in respect of the racing year commencing on 1 August 1987 and subsequent racing years.
