**REVOCATION OF BOARD OF TRADE (FOOTWEAR
MARKING) REGULATIONS 1946**

EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the revocation, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

This order revokes the Board of Trade (Footwear Marking) Regulations 1946, and comes into force on 30 June 1956.

The revocation is consequential on the making of the Footwear Marking Order 1955 which comes into force on the same date.
