#### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*[This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]*

This order revokes the Board of Trade (Onion) Regulations 1938 which provided for the grading of onions prior to sale and which set up the Onion Marketing Advisory Committee to advise the Minister of Agriculture on questions relating to the importation or exportation of onions or the production and marketing of onions in New Zealand.

Issued under the authority of the Regulations Act 1936.
