EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

This order revokes the Board of Trade (Potatoes) Regulations 1952 whereby consignments of potatoes between the South Island and the North Island were prohibited save with the consent of the Director-General of Agriculture.
