EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order, which comes into force on 18 August 1990, revokes the Customs Import Prohibition (Iraq and Kuwait) Order 1990.

A prohibition on the importation into New Zealand of any goods, being the produce or manufacture of Iraq or Kuwait, is now contained in the United Nations Sanctions (Iraq and Kuwait) Regulations 1990.
