EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

The revoked order prohibited the importation of veterinary biological products, save with the consent of the Minister of Customs. These goods fall within the term "biological products" the importation of which is now prohibited, except with the permission of the Minister of Agriculture, by section 3 of the Stock Renedies Amendment Act 1950.
