**ORDER IN COUNCIL**

At the Government House at Wellington this 23rd day of May 1983

PURSUANT to the Education Act 1964, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby revokes the following regulations:

- (a) Regulations relating to Syllabus of Instruction\*;
- (b) So much of the First Schedule to the Education (Revocation of Spent Orders in Council) Order 1980† as relates to the regulations specified in paragraph (a) of this order.

**EXPLANATORY NOTE**

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order revokes certain obsolete regulations relating to the syllabus of instruction for State primary schools. Since the passage of the Education Amendment Act (No. 2) 1982, the Minister of Education has been empowered to prescribe that syllabus by notice in the *Gazette*.
