ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington, this 22nd day of May, 1946

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE ADMINISTRATOR OF THE GOVERNMENT IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 40 of the Finance Act, 1931 (No. 2), His Excellency the Administrator of the Government of the Dominion of New Zealand, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council of the said Dominion, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Local Authorities (Replacement of Debentures) Regulations 1931, Amendment No. 1.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Local Authorities (Replacement of Debentures) Regulations 1931* (hereinafter called the principal regulations).
- 3. These regulations shall come into force on the day of notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof, and shall apply whether the loss of a debenture took place before or takes place after that date.
- 4. In any case where application is made in respect of a debenture declared to have been lost by or as a result of enemy action during the war with Germany that commenced on the 3rd day of September, 1939, and including the war with Japan, Regulations 6, 7, 8, 11, 12, and 15 of the principal regulations shall not apply, and the remaining regulations shall, where necessary, be modified accordingly.
