EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order revokes the Price Freeze Regulations (No. 6) 1973 which imposed a freeze on the charges for certain services. The charges for those services remain subject to the provisions of the Stabilisation of Prices Regulations 1974.

This order also revokes certain flour and butter subsidy reduction regulations that are spent.
