### EXPLANATORY NOTE

[This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.]

This order revokes the local fishing regulations that are specified in the Schedule to the order. Matters provided for in the revoked regulations are now contained in the Freshwater Fisheries Regulations 1951 (Serial number 1951/15), and local modifications with respect to limit bag, size limits, and methods of fishing in the district concerned are provided for in Modification Notices by the Minister of Marine which are being issued at the same time as this order.
