EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The order revokes the Hospital Boards Appointments Regulations 1972, which prescribe the manner in which certain positions on the staff of hospital boards are to be advertised. These matters are now to be dealt with by the Health Service Personnel Commission under the Health Service Personnel Act 1983.
