## EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order revokes the Hospital Boards Representation Order 1986 and its amendments, consequent upon the enactment of section 5 of the Hospitals Amendment (No. 3) Act 1988. By virtue of the amendments effected by that provision, representation is largely a matter for the Board itself, subject to any decision of the Local Government Commission.
