



## REVOCATION OF HOME-CRAFT TEACHERS' CERTIFICATES REGULATIONS

### EXPLANATORY NOTE

*This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.*

This order revokes the Home-craft Teachers' Certificates Regulations 1943 and also 3 other sets of regulations that originally contained amendments to a number of different sets of regulations, all of which have previously been revoked except for the Home-craft Teachers' Certificates Regulations 1943.
