Revocation of Potato Industry (Main Crop Levy) Regulations

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order revokes the Potato Industry (Main Crop Levy) Regulations 1980 which impose a levy on the sale of main crop potatoes for the benefit of the New Zealand Potato Growers Federation Incorporated. That body is to merge with the New Zealand Vegetable and Produce Growers' Federation Incorporated and the levy under the revoked regulations is to be replaced by a levy under the Vegetables Levy Act 1957 payable to the Vegetable and Produce Growers' Federation. The order comes into force on 7 August 1987.
