EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on 10 December 1999, revokes the Public Works (Fees for Documents) Regulations 1989. The regulations are no longer necessary because the fees they prescribed have been replaced by charges prescribed by the Survey (Departmental Fees and Charges) Regulations 1998.

As a result of the application of section 23 of the Interpretation Act 1999, the revocation of the regulations means that the following amendment regulations are also revoked:

- (a) The Public Works (Fees for Documents) Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 1 (S.R. 1993/167); and
- (b) The Public Works (Fees for Documents) Regulations 1989, Amendment No. 2 (S.R. 1995/120).
