EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

This order revokes regulations made in 1922 which require the use of metal containers for the storage of refuse and rubbish in boroughs and town districts where the local authorities make provision for the collection and disposal of refuse. The subject matter of the regulations may now be dealt with by bylaw.
