PURSUANT to the Trustee Banks Act 1983, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, by this order, which shall come into force on the 14th day after the date of its notification in the *Gazette*, revokes the Trustee Banks (Bonds and Securities) Regulations 1985*.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order revokes the Trustee Banks (Bonds and Securities) Regulations 1985. Those regulations prohibited trustee banks from issuing bonds or securities other than housing bonds, ballot bonds, or community bonds. With the revocation of those regulations a trustee bank will no longer be restricted as to the classes of bonds and securities which it may issue under the Trustee Banks Act 1983.
