EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

This order, which comes into force on the 28th day after the date of its notification in the Gazette, revokes the Customs Import Prohibition (Wool Packs) Order 1980. That order prohibits the importation of wool packs except with the consent of the Minister of Customs.
