

REVOCATION OF THE POTATO CYST NEMATODE REGULATIONS 1974

ORDER IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Plants Act 1970, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

- 1. Commencement—These regulations shall come into force on the 28th day after the date of their notification in the *Gazette*.
- 2. Regulations revoked—The Potato Cyst Nematode Regulations 1974 are hereby revoked.
- **3. Director-General may revoke declarations**—The Director-General may revoke any declaration under regulation 3 of the said regulations, notwithstanding that the potato cyst nematode may be able to be found—
 - (a) On the land to which it relates; or
 - (b) On land within 80 kilometres of it.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force 28 days after notification in the Gazette, revoke the Potato Cyst Nematode Regulations 1974.
