EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the order, but is intended to indicate its general effect.

The matters dealt with in those regulations, to the extent that they still need to be covered, are now to be covered by Treasury instructions issued under section 112 of the Public Finance Act 1977 (as substituted by section 8 of the Public Finance Amendment Act 1980).
