PURSUANT to the United Nations Act 1946, Her Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, and for the purpose of giving effect to a resolution of the Security Council of the United Nations, adopted pursuant to the United Nations Charter on the 25th day of May 1994, revoking in respect of South Africa the measures set out in a resolution of the Security Council of the United Nations, adopted pursuant to the United Nations Charter on the 4th day of November 1977, by this order, which shall come into force on the 24th day of June 1994, revokes the United Nations Sanctions (South Africa) Regulations 1980*.
