THE RATES OF WAGES EMERGENCY REGULATIONS 1940, AMENDMENT NO. 2.

ORDER IN COUNCIL.

At the Government House at Wellington, this 18th day of September, 1940.

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL.

PURSUANT to the Emergency Regulations Act, 1939, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS.

- 1. These regulations may be cited as the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940, Amendment No. 2.
- 2. These regulations shall be read together with and form part of the Rates of Wages Emergency Regulations 1940* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).
- 3. The principal regulations are amended by adding thereto the following additional regulation:—
- "12. Any general order heretofore or hereafter made by the Court in pursuance of these regulations and relating to rates of remuneration fixed by apprenticeship orders shall on and from the date of coming into effect of such general order be deemed to apply according to its tenor to all contracts of apprenticeship in force on that date and entered into subject either to the provisions of any apprenticeship order in force on that date or to the provisions of an apprenticeship order that had on that date been superseded by any subsequent apprenticeship order or orders."
