



**THE RADIATION PROTECTION REGULATIONS 1982,
AMENDMENT NO. 1**

ORDER IN COUNCIL

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to section 31 (b) of the Radiation Protection Act 1965, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Radiation Protection Regulations 1982, Amendment No. 1, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Radiation Protection Regulations 1982* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1988.

2. Fees—The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking regulation 27, and substituting the following regulation:

“27. (1) Subject to subclause (2) of this regulation, every application for the issue or renewal of a licence under the Act shall be accompanied by a fee of \$40, and no such application shall be dealt with until the fee is paid.

“(2) Where any person holds a licence to use an irradiating apparatus or a radioactive material, no fee shall be payable in respect of any application for a licence to use a radioactive material or an irradiating apparatus

respectively, or to use an irradiating apparatus or a radioactive material of other types or for other purposes than those initially included in the licence.”

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations, which come into force on 1 April 1988, increase from \$10 to \$40 the fee payable on application for the issue or renewal of a licence under the Radiation Protection Act 1965. The present exemptions for Government departments, hospitals, universities, and schools are dropped.
