**THE RABBIT-DESTRUCTION REGULATIONS 1949,

THE HON. S. G. HOLLAND PRESIDING IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Rabbit Nuisance Act, 1928, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, doth hereby make the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. These regulations may be cited as the Rabbit-destruction Regulations 1949, Amendment No. 1.

2. These regulations shall be read together with and deemed part of the Rabbit-destruction Regulations 1949 (hereinafter called the principal regulations).

3. These regulations shall come into force on the seventh day following notification in the *Gazette* of the making thereof.

4. The Second Schedule to the principal regulations is hereby amended by inserting therein the items designating the rabbit districts set forth in the Schedule hereto, next preceding respectively the items relating to the Apiti-Pohangina Rabbit District, the Eketahuna Rabbit District and the West Waikato Rabbit District.
