ORDER IN COUNCIL

At the Government House at Wellington this 26th day of September 1977

Present:

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR-GENERAL IN COUNCIL

PURSUANT to the Post Office Act 1959, His Excellency the Governor-General, acting by and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, hereby makes the following regulations.

REGULATIONS

1. Title and commencement—(1) These regulations may be cited as the Radio Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 8, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Radio Regulations 1970* (hereinafter referred to as the principal regulations).

(2) These regulations shall come into force on the 1st day of October 1977, and shall apply in respect of examinations or tests conducted on or after that date.

2. Fees payable in respect of certificates issued under Part II of the principal regulations—(1) The principal regulations are hereby amended by revoking the Second Schedule (as amended by regulation 3 (1) of the Radio Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 6), and substituting the new Second Schedule set out in the Schedule to these regulations.

(2) The Radio Regulations 1970, Amendment No. 6, are hereby consequentially amended by revoking regulation 3.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This note is not part of the regulations, but is intended to indicate their general effect.

These regulations come into force on 1 October 1977 and amend the Radio Regulations 1970 by increasing the fees for radio operators certificates for examinations taking place on or after that date.
